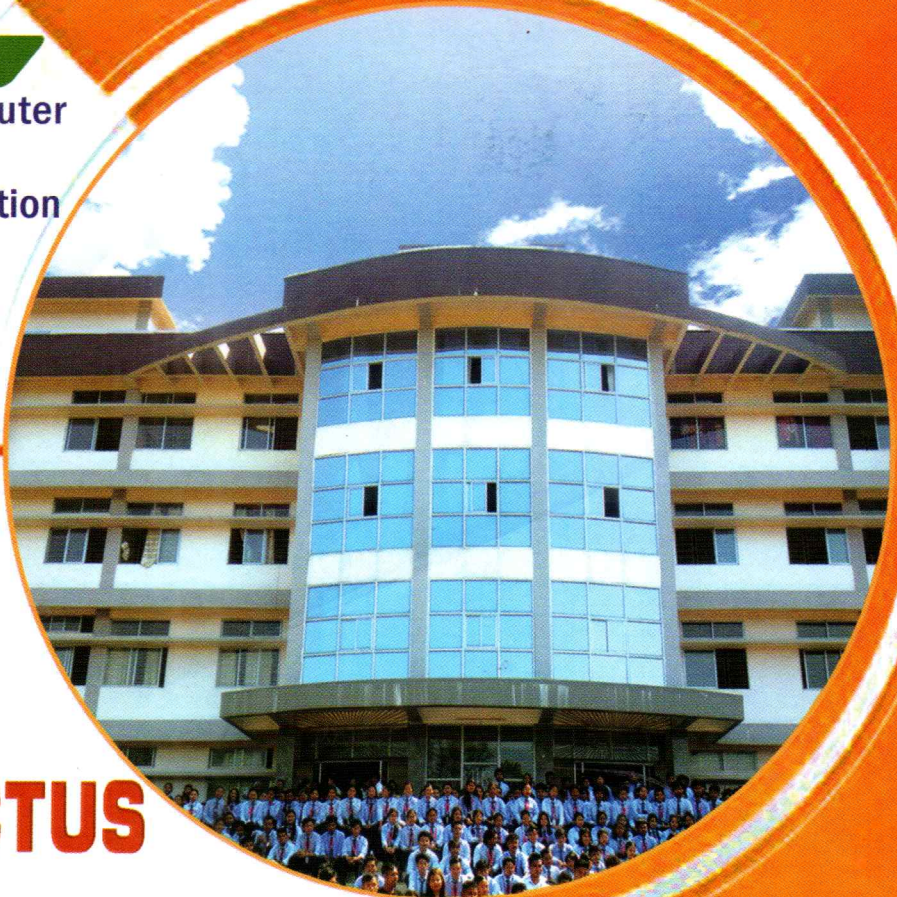

LOYOLA COLLEGE ADMISSION GUIDELINES 2026

The following are the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for admission into UG program in Loyola College as per as university guidelines

1. The first round of admission will be based on CUET scores, offered to eligible applicant on first-come, first-served basis.
2. Candidate must have passed Class XII (12th Grade) in the relevant stream from the recognized board in India or an equivalent examination recognized.
3. Subject to availability of vacant seats, the admission window for non-CUET candidates will be open five (5) days subsequently to the announcement of the list of candidates admitted based on CUET scores.
4. Eligibility for FYUP in Arts, Commerce & Science (NEP), and Higher Secondary examination with minimum Arts: 40% marks, Commerce: 50% marks & Science: 50% marks.
5. Admission forms and prospectus can be purchased from the College office on payment of Rs. 400.
6. Short listed candidates name will be displayed in the college notice board. Candidates will appear for the interview accompanied by parents. They will meet the Principal/Vice-Principal/Staff at the appointed time and date for the interview.

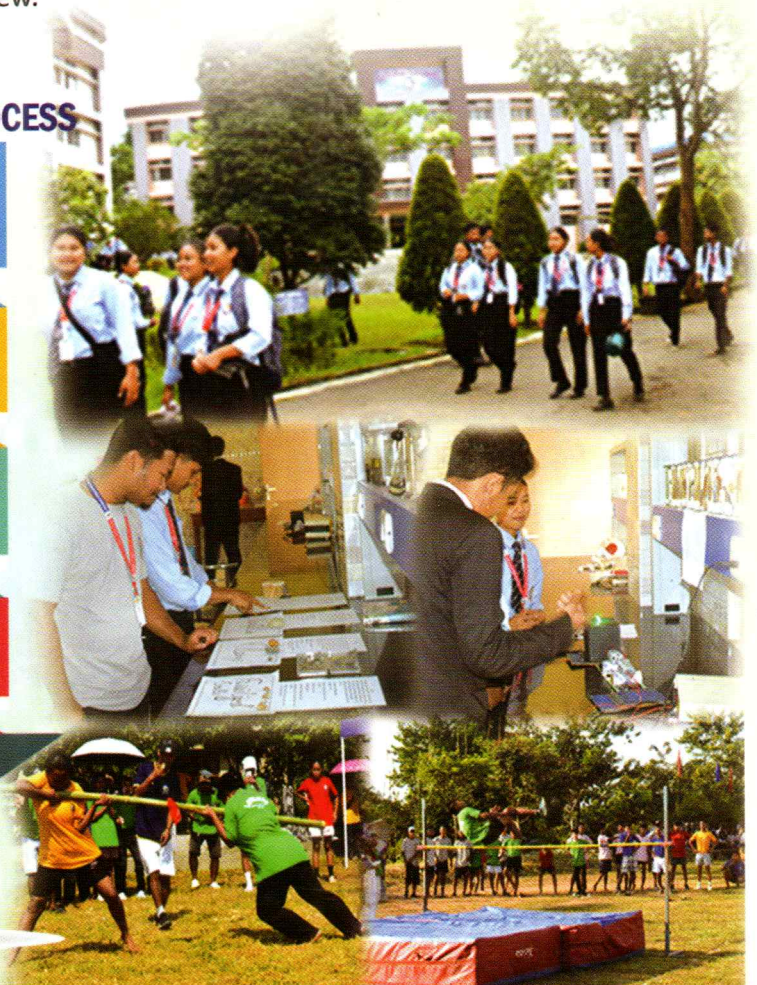
