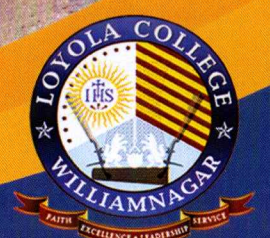
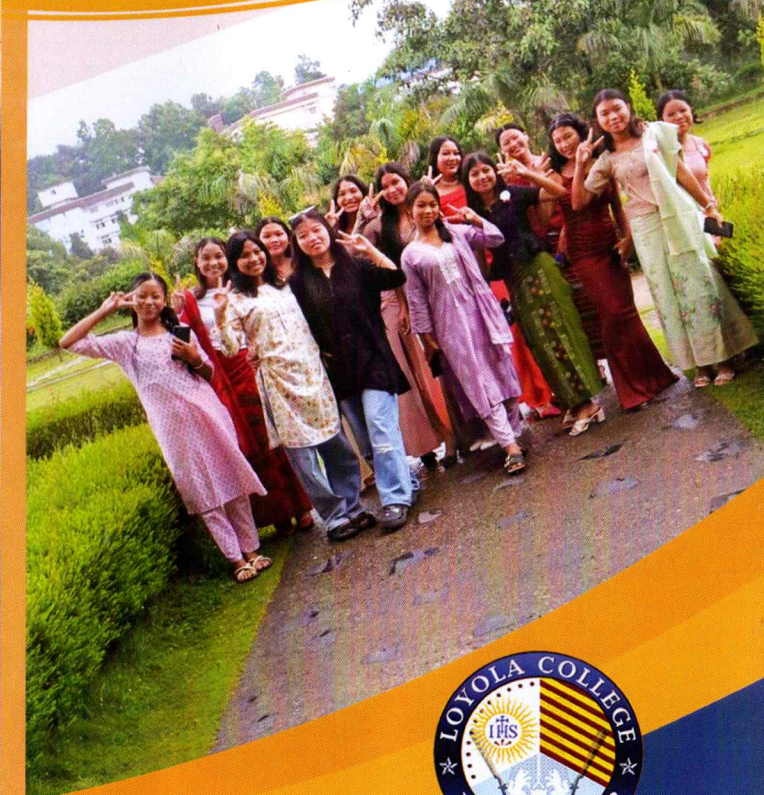

Admission: 1 st instalment	₹ 6,000.00

Loyola Hostels offer students a “Home away from home” during their college years. Besides providing students with a secure and comfortable place to live and study, the hostel also fosters in students the values of academic excellence (Magis), hard work, faith formation, service and discipline in the Ignatian tradition.

To create a sense of community, the hostel fosters close bonds of friendship among the hostellers and a spirit of cura personalis and respect for each other.

ADMISSION

Application forms are available in the College Office on payment of ₹ 300. The duly filled Admission Form must be submitted to the College office (Gents) and Ladies’ Hostel office (Ladies) for admission.

English is the official language on the campus, and thus, students admitted to the hostel should speak English.

Respect for others, openness to growth, a desire for serious study, and a willingness to live with members of other ethnic and linguistic communities are prerequisites for admission to the hostel.



FACILITIES AND PROGRAMMES

Hostellers will be accommodated in 3-seater, 4-seater, 5-seater and 6-seater rooms that are provided with the required furniture for study and rest.

A variety of programmes for personality and language development are organized. Every hosteller is required to take part in the programmes, value education sessions and talent competitions, cultural get-together, prayer service and indoor and outdoor sports and games.

STUDY TIME AND SILENCE

The study hours must be spent in silence. All hostellers have to be present for the Roll Call, which may be taken at any time at the discretion of the warden.



HOSTEL RULES

1. Hostellers are responsible for their own personal belongings. They are advised to keep their cupboards and suitcases securely locked. The Hostel Management is not responsible for any theft.
2. Hostellers are permitted to leave the hostel premises only with the Warden’s permission. They must fill in the necessary details on the logbook, indicating the time of leaving and returning. Upon their return, they should meet the Warden immediately.
3. Hostellers are not allowed to stay outside the hostel during weekends and during the short holidays. However, permission will be given at the request of parents/guardians, either in person or via phone, registered with the college.
4. Hostellers have to be present for the Roll Call, which will be done whenever appropriate, as per the discretion of the Warden.
5. The use of mobile phones is regulated during study and sleep hours. Mobile phones have to be deposited in the warden’s office after the night prayer. Failure to comply with this rule will invite consequences amounting to confiscation.
6. The consumption of alcohol, drugs, and other addictive substances is strictly prohibited. Anyone violating this rule could be expelled.
7. Damage or destruction of hostel property will be charged to the concerned person as per the damage.
8. Anyone found threatening, defaming, or instigating trouble against another student or staff member will be seriously dealt with and depending on the gravity of the issue, the concerned student could be expelled without a warning.
9. Hostellers are required to get a “**fee clearance certificate**” from the office and the signatures of the hostel warden, the librarian, and from the fee counter to get their certificates/TC/Marks card.
